## **SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES**

# **DECEMBER 27, 2021**

## 6:00

- 1. Call to Order: Brian Smith called meeting to order at 6:00 PM.
- 2. Review Minutes of Previous Meetings (2): Mike Hinerman seconded motion of Jeff Davis to accept minutes as presented. All in favor, motion carried.
- **3.** Adjustments to Agenda: Adjustments not made; first order of business is to open bids for property at Indian Point.

### 4. Old Business:

- AA. Open bids for Indian Point: Brian opened two bids at meeting. Bid #1 from Gary and Maria Lamb in the amount of \$64,100, check for \$6410 enclosed. Bid #2 from Michael Johnson in the amount of \$12,000 with \$1200 check enclosed. Brian Smith seconded motion of Mike Hinerman to accept the bid of \$64,100.00 All in favor, motion carried.
- A. Aschettino Follow-up: Robert Arseneau updated Selectmen on communications between himself and Paula Aschettino and her request for Planning Board documents regarding the subdividing of Anne Louise Thompson-Granfield's property. Paula believes the subdivision ordinance was violated in this transaction. However, Robert explained to her that that is not the case. The subdivision ordinance pertains to a property being divided into three sections within a 5-year period. Robert stated he provided copies of state documents to Paula for her review. Robert believes he has satisfied her temporarily, but feels she still has a plan to find fault with the Town.
- B. Aschettino Email: Mike Hinerman requested copy of this email be entered into the permanent record as the Selectmen refute all Mrs. Aschettino's claims. He added no comment will be made by the Selectmen, but by the Town's Attorney when appropriate. (Copy included in file)
