4. Old Business:

A. RAM truck – sell repair: Selectmen tabled this item until next Month when Jeff is back in attendance.

B. Roof Bids: Bids were opened, and Selectmen discussed differences in each.

5. New Business:

Brian Smith read notice from Town Attorney, Stephen Wagner, regarding the commenting of ongoing litigation. Brian explained that the Town is being sued regarding Beach Road and Selectmen have been advised not to comment, so there will be no discussion of Beach Road tonight.

A. Beach Road: Jimmy Clark- Selectmen's intentions and plans: Jimmy had several questions regarding this statement and Brian reminded him that they would not be discussing the issue tonight.

- B. New Streetlights on East Side: Ryan and Brian discussed need for lights at Old Bay Rd and Pritchard Lane. Brian Smith seconded the motion of Ryan Sprague to install streetlights at above locations as discussed. All in favor, motion carried.
- **C. Liberty Hall Grant Application:** Brian spoke of the need for letters of support for a grant the Friends of Liberty Hall would like to submit to complete the interior of the building.

The position has been advertised and two applications have been received. Bob Mercer reminded board of LD101 which will change the requirements for a Town foreclosing on properties for taxes. Brian explained a situation brought to the attention of the Town whereby the State has introduced a bill LD501 to sell the property in Machiasport known as base housing. Discussion ensued.
